Regular Meeting

April 8, 2019

Mayor Laggis opened the monthly meeting at 7:00. In attendance were Mayor Laggis as well as Councilmen Frank Carden, Kenny Wright and Jack Gilson. The minutes from March's meeting were approved with Councilman Wright making the motion and Councilman Carden seconding it. Motion passed.

Financial Report

Old Business

1. Zoning Ordinance Status – Revised copy of Zoning Ordinance was handed out. Clerk needs to be told by April 18th if public hearing can be held at the monthly meeting in May so that it can be advertised in a timely manner.

New Business

1. Resolution #2019-04 – Approved unanimously with Councilman Wright making the motion to accept the resolution as written and the motion was seconded by Councilman Carden.

2. Briefing by Sheriff Babb – Sheriff Babb came to meeting to update the Council on crime statistics, staffing levels, etc. Councilman Carden made a motion to supply a letter to the Sheriff, if and when he needs it, to submit to the County Commissioners to assist the Sheriff's Department in hiring and retaining officers for the purpose of keeping Fayette County safe. Councilman Gilson seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

3. Other – Mayor Laggis informed the Council that Dr. Barrow, from the FCBOE, said that they will be holding an Open House in their "new" facility. All of the conference rooms will be named after the towns in Fayette County and they are looking for items from each town to be displayed in their respective conference room. Mayor Laggis asked Councilman Gilson to be the point person from Woolsey.

With no more business to come before the council, the meeting was adjourned at 11:00 pm.
