Minutes of Meeting

Clerk absent at March meeting. Councilman Wright will have at the May meeting for approval.

Financial Report

Councilman Smith made a motion to approve the April Financial Report as submitted. Councilman Wright seconded him. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

1. Comprehensive Plan Update – The public open house was held in March. Councilman Smith reported that the survey was sent to the Woolsey citizens and they have had a good response. Ryan from ARC will put together the plan and submit it to the committee for tweaking. The public hearing will be in May. Mayor Pro Tem Carden remarked that he had looked at the survey and saw good comments.

New Business

1. Safe Digging Month Proclamation – Matt Bergen, Project Manager for Environmental Management, requested that the Town Council proclaim April as Safe Digging Month. Councilman Smith asked what the typical response time was after calling 811 and Mr. Bergen said that it was 48 hours by law. Mayor Pro Tem Carden commented about the importance of calling 811. He then went on to read the proclamation. Councilman Wright made the motion to approve the proclamation as read. Councilman Smith seconded and the proclamation was signed.

Other – Clerk informed Council that the current owner of the Chevron is working with someone to take over the running of the business. The new person will have to get a new alcohol license from both the Town and the State.

With no more business to come in front of the Council, Councilman Wright made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:19 p.m. He was seconded by Councilman Smith. Motion passed unanimously.
