Minutes of Meeting

Councilman Smith made a motion to approve the minutes from the November meeting as written. Councilman Carden seconded him. Councilman Wright concurred and the motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report

Councilman Wright made a motion to approve the Financial Report as submitted. Councilman Carden seconded him and Councilman Smith concurred. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

- 1. Transportation Update Mayor Laggis gave the report for Caitlin who was unable to attend the meeting. The gas line location has been completed and it is further back than originally thought. They are working on locating the underground tanks. The Town will be hosting the Transportation Committee meeting on the first Tuesday in April at 1:30. Mayor Laggis also reported that the pipe for the culvert on Anna Lane is in and will be installed relatively soon.
- 2. Painting Proposal Review A&M Remodeling Services came in at \$4,450 but does not carry insurance. H&O Painters came in at \$5,200 but does carry insurance. After some discussion Councilman Wright made the motion to go with H&O Painters in accordance with their bid. Councilman Smith seconded the motion, Councilman Carden concurred and motion passed unanimously.

New Business

- 1. FY2023 Budget Review Mayor Laggis told the Council that in 2020 the Community Center hosted 16 events which brought in \$2,800 in rental fees, in 2021 it was 20 events and \$3,875 in rental fees and as of this date, 2022 has had 36 events and has brought in approximately \$8,925. Councilman Wright commented that having something that we give back to the town is good. Councilman Carden noted that 2023 is an election year and that we should budget some money for that line item (he and Councilman Wright are up for re-election). A public Hearing on the budget will be held in January.
